The Ipswich Poetry Feast is an exciting initiative of Ipswich City Council, supported and driven by the local community. The Poetry Feast has flourished since it was introduced in 2002 with the aim of establishing a respected and prestigious national poetry competition to:

- Raise community awareness of the creativity and skills in poetry writing
- Promote and showcase Ipswich as a vibrant, culturally rich region

BACKGROUND

In the latter part of the 19th century two young children, Bridget and Mary Broderick, drowned at a waterhole that lies in the township of Walloon. This tragic event was the subject of a poem penned by Henry Lawson in the 1890's titled *The Babies of Walloon*. The impetus for the Ipswich Poetry Feast came from this tragedy and poem.

Guidelines and Conditions of Entry

- All entries must be received by Friday, 27 July 2018 at 5.00 pm. No late entries will be accepted.
- Each entry must be the entrant's/author's original work. Any plagiarised content will automatically disqualify the poet from the competition.
- Each entry must be submitted in the English language, not previously published for individual profit or having won a major prize in any literary competition at time of entry.
- There is no word limit.
- Poems may be on any subject and may be entered in more than one category (fee applies for each entry in Open Age categories).
- No name or other identifying material should appear on the poem. Poems will be judged anonymously.
- In the Open Age Bush Poetry Category the following definition applies: Australian bush poetry with good rhyme and meter which is written about Australia, its people, places, things and way of life.
- In the Open Age Local Poets Category the following condition of entry applies: entrants must live, work or attend an educational institution within the boundaries of Ipswich City Council
- In the Open Age Picture Ipswich Theme Category poems must be based on, and accompanied by, the relevant image and Reference No from the Picture Ipswich website. Picture Ipswich is a collection of historical photographs and documents that record the lives and times of Ipswich from early settlement to the present day. Picture.Ipswich.qld.gov.au
- \$5.00 fee per entry payable to Ipswich City Council for Open Age categories. Free entry in 5-17 years of age categories.
- Open Age international entrants must submit entries via online entry form. International cheques will not be accepted.

For Printed Entries:

- One entry form per poem. Entrant to supply two copies of poem.
- Entries to be typed or computer printed in Arial 12pt on one side of A4 white paper.
- All pages must be numbered in sequence - ie 1 of 2, 2 of 2.
- Submissions will not be returned. It is the responsibility of the writer to keep a copy.

For Online Open Age Entries:

- Submissions and payments to be made via Eventbrite.

Judging and Notification:

- Judges' decisions are final.
- Judges reserve the right to transfer poems between categories in the Open Bush and Open Other section where deemed appropriate.
- Winners will be contacted prior to the Awards Presentation event proposed for October 2018. Winners will be announced, first prize winning poems (or an excerpt of these poems) will be professionally read, and prizes presented (where possible) at this event. Prizes will be mailed if winner cannot attend in person.
- The committee reserves the right to publish or broadcast, without fee to the author, in part or in whole, award winning or commended entries and photographs on the website, in an anthology and/or in media publications or broadcasts. Copyright remains with the author thereafter.
- The committee also reserves the right to give entrants' contact details to the media, if among the winners.
- Results will be published following the Awards Presentation, and will be posted shortly thereafter on the Ipswich Poetry Feast website at Ipswichpoetryfeast.com.au
